

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

We believe uniform looks smart and contributes to a sense of belonging. Our policy has the support of parents and governors as the majority of children come to school in the correct uniform. The same school uniform and P.E. clothing is worn by all pupils of all ages 4-11, attending the school. It is chosen from the following

### UNIFORM

White shirt, polo shirt or blouse  
Royal blue sweatshirt (with school motif)  
Royal blue sweatshirt cardigan (with school motif)

Conventional grey or black trousers

Grey skirt or pinafore dress  
Summer cotton dress in blue and white

White navy-blue or grey socks  
White, navy-blue or grey tights

Conventional outdoor shoes in dark colours (dark blue, black or grey)

### NOTE The following clothing is not allowed:

Boots, sandals, trainers or plimsolls, jeans, brightly coloured socks, "designer wear"

Small, discrete studs are allowed providing children can remove them independently for PE sessions. We suggest that piercing ears is best left for a summer holiday to allow time for a child to become confident at removing them. A small watch is also permitted but no other forms of jewellery or large hair fashion which becomes a distraction is allowed.

### P.E.

The change into proper clothing for Physical Education ensures that all children participate equally, hygienically and safely. We encourage the children to take home their PE kits each Friday and return them on the Monday so that it is always available. Forgetting kit is not an excuse for missing PE. We have a limited stock of borrowed kit or children may be required to do games in their everyday clothes or vest and pants. The following is worn by all children, but children in KS2 classes require additional clothing for wearing outside, particularly in winter.

### KS1 pupils 4-7 years for inside use

T shirt with short sleeves in house colour  
Royal blue P.E. shorts  
Draw string bag

### KS2 pupils 8-11 years

T shirt with short sleeves in house colours  
Royal blue P.E. shorts  
Warm fleecy-lined sweat-shirt in blue and plain blue jogging bottoms in very cold weather  
OR  
Tracksuit in blue

Football boots will be needed by some older pupils; please ask at the school before purchasing these. All children need to change into P E plimsolls or Trainers for work on the field or playground.

### SAFETY NOTES

1. Ear-rings should be removed during all P.E. activities and are not allowed in the pool.
2. Trainers are not allowed for *Gymnastics*; all indoor work is done in bare feet.
3. Long hair should be securely tied back and all loose clothing tucked in. If hair is below the ear, a swimming hat is required for both boys and girls.
4. Long and baggy shorts or any tops with drawstring or buttons are not allowed
